

Proposition #1

School Budget Vote for the 2023 – 2024 School Year - \$52,476,480

"SHALLTHE BOARD OF EDUCATION of the Highland Central School District be authorized to expend for budgetary purposes in the 2023 – 2024 school year the sum of \$52,476,480 and to levy the necessary tax therefore?

Proposition #2

School Bus Purchase Proposition 2022-23

SHALL the Board of Education of the Highland Central School District be authorized to: (1) acquire two school buses at a maximum cost of approximately \$266,756; (2) expend such sum for such purpose; (3) levy the necessary tax therefore, to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education taking into account state aid; and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issue bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed \$266,756, and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due?

 - Qualified voters of the District who are not registered with Ulster County or have not voted at any annual or special school elections within the past four years, may register for the Annual Meeting and Election at the HCSD Central Office, on any business day between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. through May 11, 2023.

Voter Qualifications:

- ✓ A United States citizen
- ✓ Registered to vote
- √ 18 years of age or older
- ✓ A resident of Highland Central School District for at least 30 days, immediately prior to the vote
- ✓ Not otherwise prohibited from voting under the provisions of Section 5-106 of the Election Law (e.g. a person who had been adjudged to be mentally incompetent)
